SYLLABUS:

To be able to speak, read, write and understand all Gujarati alphabets and the barakhadi from the beginning and in order. They should be able to speak, read, write and understand all the vowels. They must write in print quality. They must speak clearly using the correct sounds. They must say it together as well as individually. They should be able to use barakhadi. to write and read two, three or more letter words and know the meaning in English. They should be able to make sentences. They should be able to translate sentences and paragraphs into English to Gujarati to English. They should have a knowledge of simple grammar, such as all three Tenses etc. They should read fluently. They should be prepared at **G C S E , A S & A2 Examinations** level. They should be able to write small stories, essays and letters. They should be able to read from Gujarati newspapers & Magazines. They should know the Gujarati calendar months.

They must be able to Speak, Read, Write & understand numbers from 1 to 100, 1000 and 1 to 100 in words.

The class can be distributed into groups by the ability of the students.

Suggestion for the use of **BOOKS** to cover the work for different groups. There are many other Gujarati books as well as for the G C S E, AS & A2 examination preparation available in the market could be use to teach in the class.

All the students should be able to read, understand, write and translate words and sentences. Students should be able to read and write joined-up letters.

Bhasha Pravesh, I Bhasha Pravesh II, Dhoran two, & three and the Swadhyay books Nibundhmala ONE & Nibundhmala TWO are the books used for this class.

Teachers can breakdown the syllabus term wise according to the ability & co-operation of students and divide them into groups.

It is important to concentrate on **correct pronunciation** when reading takes place & the correct basic way of writing should be followed. (The dotted diagram of letters of alphabet can be useful to teach correct basic way of writing.)

ACTIVITIES

To tell stories in connection with culture, religion, mythology, fiction in Gujarati, important date etc. Recite poems and prayers in Gujarati. Use large posters, objects, toys, colour pictures, television, video etc. to teach. Understanding of festivals and important dates for Gujarat in one calendar year. Painting or colouring pictures and creative activities. Different topics on GCSE standard should be cover in assembly.

At all time **GUJARATI** must be spoken in the class.
